

Dear STEM Initiative Grant Program Committee,

Math Field Day is an opportunity for students in grades 4-8 to use mathematical reasoning and teamwork through competition. Math Field Day replaced the former Torrance Regional Middle School Math Competition starting 2017. Participating students demonstrate their math knowledge through competition in the following events: computational and procedural skills, conceptual understanding and problem-solving. The winners from the Torrance Unified School District's Math Field Day get invited to attend and compete at the Los Angeles County Office of Education Math Field Day in April every year.








Over 180 middle school students came out and competed at the TUSD Math Field Day in the last two years. Based on the results of the competition each year, a group of 12 students in Grades 6-8 represented Torrance Unified School District at the LACOE Math Field Day. Each team competed against 36 other southern california districts and did a phenomenal job placing in the top three places every year.

This year, we are very excited to invite Math Field Day to our 17 elementary schools and share the excitement of math to 4th and 5th graders. Below is a proposed budget to run the event at two levels of schools. If we were to receive the TEF STEM Grant it would pay for the registration fee for our students to attend the LACOE Math Field Day in April, 2019 (\$200 per team, 5 teams total for grade 4-6,  $$200 \times 5 = $1000$ ).
